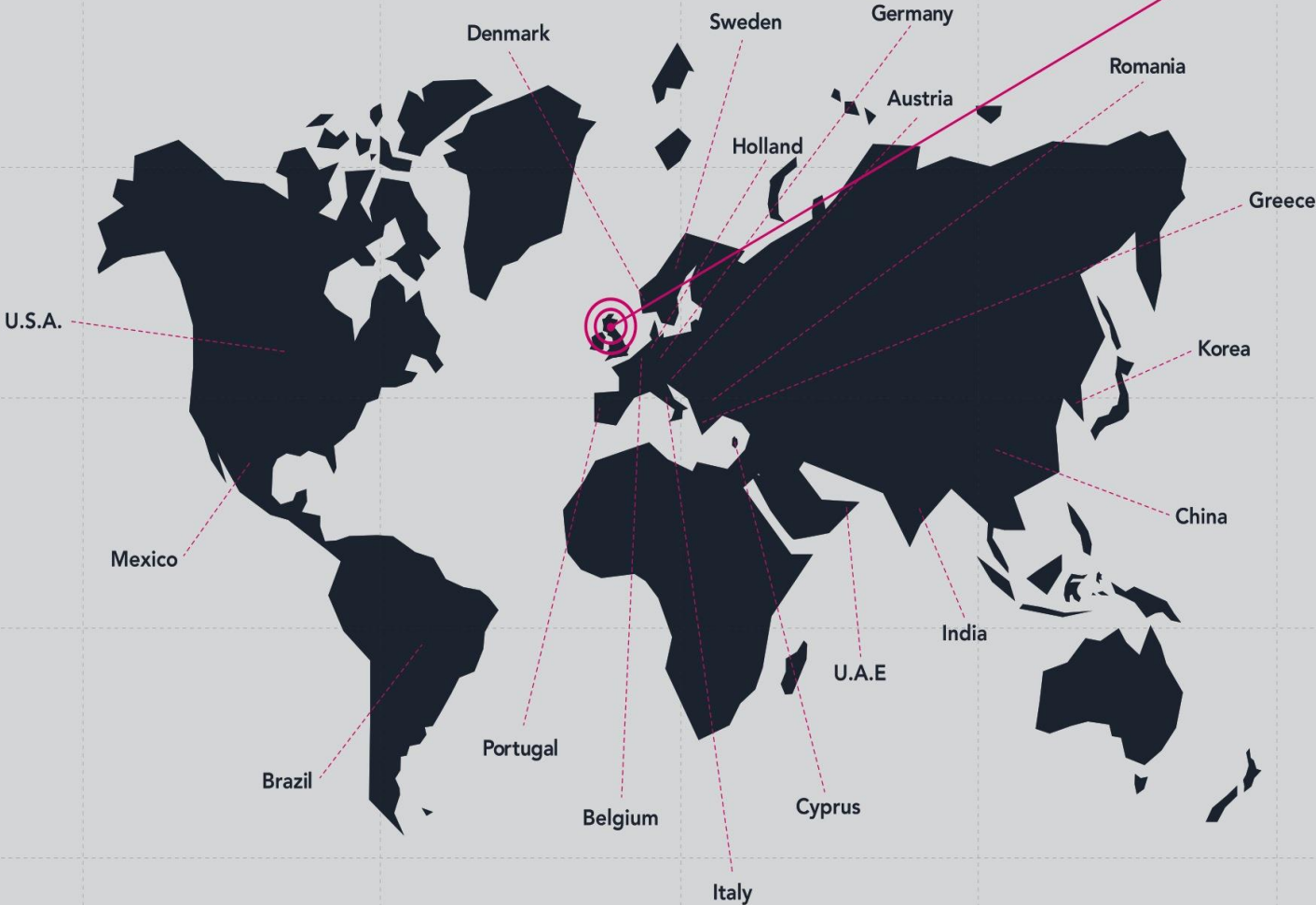

## Creative Learning workshops in India

- **Chennai** - for advanced dancers, non-dance specialist staff and children with and without disabilities and in Orphanages
- **Bangalore** - for advanced dancers
- **Kolkata** - skills share with Sanved Ranan who improve the life of vulnerable people using Dance Movement Therapy
- **Pondicherry** - inter-disciplinary Collabatory with Scottish and Indian artists from dance, visual arts, theatre and music
- **The Sundarbans** - the area is isolated by its location in a mangrove ecosystem influenced by daily tidal flows. We worked with 35 young people in the school playground on Bali Island and also with a women's group, Disha.
