Mother Tongue

encourages children, who do not speak English as a first language, to create a lullaby, poem, rap or song in their mother tongue and to write a short commentary in English detailing the inspiration behind their writing. In Scotland, pupils will be able to submit commentaries on Scots and Gaelic texts in this category as well as BSL.

Other Tongue

encourages children, learning another language in school (French, Spanish, German, Italian, Mandarin, Urdu, Gaelic, BSL and Cantonese) to use that language creatively by writing an original poem, rap or song in that other tongue. A short accompanying text should also be included outlining their inspiration.
