StampIT also provides a number of ideas for teachers to use stamps across the curriculum. Stamps are a great medium for learning about a wide range of subjects.









StampIT's activities are free to all and can be used within the classroom or home learning, making it ideal for any blended learning environment.

<u>StamplT's website</u> has a brand new look and launching soon is 'Stamp over October'. This series develops various skills and increases knowledge across the curriculum for the *broad general education* phase. The range of activities cover *experiences and outcomes* in many areas within *expressive arts; language and literacy; mathematics; sciences; social studies* and *technologies*. The activities will also last beyond October!

'Stamp over October' includes daily activity plans (less formal than lesson plans but still include *key learning aims*). Some involve competitions and challenges, some involve sharing the child's work, some involve a limited number of free give-aways. All develop important key skills.



StampIT has language games and <u>language competitions</u> for <u>Spanish</u>, <u>French</u>, <u>Mandarin</u> & <u>Japanese</u>. (Sound files are available in the Mandarin & Japanese online versions.) StampIT is always evolving so please continue to check the website for new games.
