Spirit mask



What is it?

This mask from Gabon portrays a beautiful female spirit.

What is it for?

It is worn by male dancers at funerals and celebrations of important members of the community.

How was it made?

It was made in the early 20th century by a tribe called The Punu. The Punu people made beautiful masks from wood, clay and raffia. They painted them with pigment. A white mask represented the ghost of an ancestor from the afterworld.
